Candidate Statements

Candidates may submit a statement to be included with ballot material. Only statements which comply with the Rules and are received by the Returning Officer by 12:00 Noon (Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT)) on 14/12/2021 can be accepted.

The candidate statement is to be provided in the form of an electronic file, be restricted to a maximum of 400 words per candidate and may include a passport sized photograph. The material may include an indication of preference provided that all candidates are shown in the order they appear on the ballot paper and there is a preference allocated to each candidate.

The appointment of scrutineers opens on 23/11/2021 and closes 5:00pm Australian Eastern Daylight Time (AEDT) on 28/02/2022.
