The rally, to be held on Sunday 5 April, will commence at Belmore Park from 2pm.

Members, their families and communities are urged to attend the rally and show that we are prepared to stand up for refugees and reject the racist government policies affecting so many.

The theme for the Palm Sunday Rally this year is "Justice, Peace, Unity", with the main message being "It's time for Australia to end the torture of Nauru and PNG".

Australia is obligated by the United Nations Convention to protect those seeking asylum and despite continued national and international condemnation, the inhumane treatment of asylum seekers and the vilification of refugees continues.
